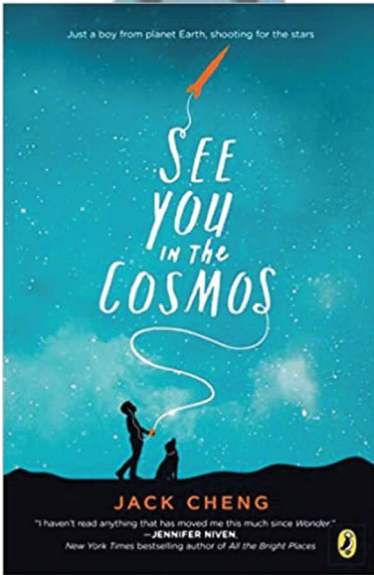




# Looking for a good book?
